



Fri 8 Sep: Welcome to Paris!

Bonjour! Tonight we head to the opening ceremony and game one - New Zealand vs France. *Overnight: Paris*

Sat 9 Sep: Paris City Tour Today we visit many of Paris's

sightseeing highlights. Overnight: Paris

Sun 10 Sep: Barcelona

We head south to Barcelona to explore the best of Catalan culture. *Overnight: Barcelona*

Mon 11 Sep: Sagrada Familia Tour

This morning we take a tour of one of Barcelona's most famous landmarks, the Sagrada Familia. *Overnight: Barcelona*

Tue 12 Sep: La Pedrera & Park Guell

Today we visit two more iconic locations designed by Antoni Gaudi. Casa Mila, colloquially known as La Pedrera ('the stone quarry'). Park Guell was originally intended as a housing development where the city's elite. Overnight: Barcelona

Wed 13 Sep: Montserrat Tour

Located 50km northwest of Barcelona, Montserrat is a unique series of rock formations sitting 1,200 metres above sea level, and home to a monastery established in the 11th century. *Overnight: Barcelona*

Thu 14 Sep: Transfer to Toulouse Today we travel through classic French countryside en route to Toulouse. *Overnight: Toulouse*

Fri 15 Sep: City Tour & New Zealand v Africa 1

Today we take a tour of the historic city centre before heading to Stade de Toulouse for tonight's match! *Overnight: Toulouse*

Sat 16 Sep: Toulouse

We have one final day to enjoy in la Ville Rose - the Pink City. *Overnight: Toulouse*

Sun 17 Sep: Narbonne City Tour Today we travel to the Mediterranean city of Narbonne. After dropping our luggage at tonight's hotel we will take a walking tour of the old town.

Thu 21 Sep: Avignon City Tour



Mon 25 Sep: Transfer to Munich This morning we travel to Munich for Oktoberfest beer festival - a festival that has to be seen to be believed! *Overnight: Munich*

After our walking tour of the old town we return for more Oktoberfest action. *Overnight: Munich*

Wed 27 Sep: Dachau Tour

Wed 4 Oct: Lyon Transfer Today we return to Lyon. Overnight: Lyon

Thu 5 Oct: Lyon City Tour & New Zealand v Uruguay

This morning we embark on a tour of Lyon before heading out to OL Stadium for the AB's final pool match! *Overnight: Lyon*

Fri 6 Oct: France v Italy

This morning we ride on the funicular to Fouviere's Basilica of Notre-Dame before France take on Italy. *Overnight: Lyon*

Sat 7 Oct: Biarritz Transfer Today we travel to the stunning resort town of Biarritz. This afternoon we take a walking tour of this playground of Frances rich and famous. *Overnight: Biarritz*

Thu 12 Oct: Saint-Emilion Winery Tour Saint-Emilion's steep, narrow streets are lined with churches and ruins. We head to one of the region's top wineries. *Overnight: Bordeaux*

Fri 13 Oct: Paris

Today we return to Paris. Overnight: Paris

Sat 14 Oct: Quarter-final 2

Tonight's quarter-final features the winner of Pool B (South Africa, Ireland or Scotland) and the runner up of New Zealand's Pool A. *Overnight: Paris*

Sun 15 Oct: Quarter-final 4

Explore more of Paris before we watch the last quarter-final. *Overnight: Paris*

Mon 16 Oct: Dijon

We head to France's historic Burgundy region famous for the eponymous wines, food and a famous condiment! *Overnight: Dijon*

Tue 17 Oct: Dijon City Tour

This morning we embark on a walking tour of Dijon's UNESCO-listed old town. *Overnight: Dijon*

Wed 18 Oct: Burgundy Winery Tour

Today we tour one of the top wineries to sample the famous pinot noir. *Overnight: Dijon*

Thu 19 Oct: Paris Transfer

This morning we return to Paris where

all of our tour groups come together for a big night on the town! *Overnight: Paris*

Fri 20 Oct: City tour & semi-final 1

Today we tour more of Paris before we head to the magnificent Stade de France for semi-final 1. *Overnight: Paris*

Sat 21 Oct: Semi-final 2

Today we explore more of the French capital and then return to Stade de France for tonight's second semi-final. *Overnight: Paris*

Sun 22 Oct: Normandy

This morning we depart Paris and begin our tour of the French battlefields and memorials of the World Wars. *Overnight: Caen*

Mon 23 Oct: Bayeux

Today we visit more of the Normandy WW2 battlefields and then visit the medieval town of Bayeux. *Overnight: Caen*

Tue 24 Oct: Amiens & the Somme Today we head north to the city of Amiens and the Somme battlefields. *Overnight: Amiens*

Wed 25 Oct: Villers-Bretonneux Today we head to the town of VillersBretonneux where Australian soldiers famously fought during WW1. We then travel to the capital of France's traditional Champagne region, Reims. *Overnight: Reims*

Thu 26 Oct: Champagne Winery Tour

First stop today is a winery in France's famed Champagne region where we will hear the history while sampling a glass before we return to Paris ahead of the climax of Rugby World Cup 2023! *Overnight: Paris*

Fri 27 Oct: Palace of Versailles Tour


